

Spending a Lot of Time at the Doctor's?

Learn about a study of an investigational vaccine for people who may be at risk of *Clostridium difficile* (*C. diff*).



People who are taking antibiotics or are being treated at a hospital or healthcare facility have an increased chance of getting sick due to *C. diff*. *C. diff* can cause frequent diarrhoea, abdominal pain, and inflammation of the colon, which, when severe, can be life threatening.

- Have you had at least 2 visits to Accident and Emergency, or been hospitalised for at least two nights, in the last 12 months? **or**
- Are you a resident in a nursing facility? **or**
- Do you have a planned surgery that will require a hospital stay of 2 nights or more?

If you are at least 50 years of age and answered yes to any of the questions above, you may be eligible to participate in a study being done to evaluate the effectiveness of an investigational vaccine for reducing the chance of getting *C. diff*.
